Regular Meeting Minutes June 19, 2012

Present: Chairman Groselle, Steve Pancost, Kathy Schulda

Chairman Groselle opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and the reading of the June 5, 2012 minutes. Steve Pancost motioned to approve the minutes as corrected. Kathy Schulda seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Groselle AYE, Pancost AYE, Schulda AYE. The minutes were approved.

Resolution was presented to the Trustees for the 2 mill replacement road levy. Steve motioned to approve the Resolution 2012-10. Kathy seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Jack AYE, Schulda AYE, Steve AYE. Resolution 2012-10 is approved and will be given to the Auditor's Office.

Todd Peetz, Director of the Portage County Regional Planning Commission, talked about different regional plans being put together and how it will influence Hiram Township. Discussion continued on the update of our comprehensive plan. Having our plan updated may also help to get grants.

Fire Report: Everything is running sooth.

Old Business:

We are in the running for some grant money from a grant that the Commissioner's Office will handle. It has been extended until August 31st.

The Lady is still upset about not being legal to concrete her drive to the road and is still complaining.

Kathy will be meeting with the Representative from Middlefield Bank concerning the property at 12955 Thrasher/Rapids Road.

Letters will be sent to the Portage County Sheriff's and the Ohio State Highway Patrol Offices asking to help slow down the speeding cars in the Township.

Jack asked about a call he received concerning our 941 forms not being sent to the IRS. Stan will be meeting with Doug Brewer to help take care of this.

Tom has also talked to the person that has the mailbox that is fortified. The person, after talking with his insurance agent, will be removing it and putting up a breakaway mail box.

New Business: Steve has met with people representing the Couch Trust concerning purchasing property from them. This is still in the discussion stage.

Steve has also talked with Alfred Schrader concerning the lawsuit and not much has changed.

Nine students from the Crestwood School District will be going to NEOMED this fall and the Crestwood School Board may not want to provide transportation for them. A letter will be sent to the Crestwood School Board showing our support for the students and asking to make sure transportation is provided.

Kathy Schulda moved to descend Resolution 2012-7 "Trustees" intention to strictly adhere to the Ohio Sunshine Law". Steve Pancost seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Groselle AYE, Schulda AYE, Pancost AYE. Resolution 2012-7 has been rescinded.

The Ohio Public Works Commission District Seven Townships is asking for 3 representatives for the Local Integrating Committee. Jack will be being information to the next meeting so the Trustees can vote on three instead of only two.

Advertisement will be put in the Record Courier telling of the Budget Hearing at the July 3, 2012 meeting.

Zoning Report: Rich Gano was not able to attend, but did send a letter telling of no change at Blazeks. He also stopped on Alpha Road concerning some digging with nothing to report.

A permit was drawn up for an addition to a house on Alpha Road.

He stopped at Essell's property to inspect and was able to inspect the aircraft and facilities. He found three aircraft. Mr. Essell also complained about Mr. Pinter bringing work home.

Road Report: Tom Matota reported on the widening of Schustrich Road and how nice it is turning out. And fill has been taken to the berm on Norton Road to repair the edge.

People have been asking about flags along different roads in the township. Tom informed us that they are for the oil and gas exploration and to do testing of the soil. They have a bond with the County Engineer's Office and will check to see if the township roads are covered under it.
