Chairman Groselle opened the meeting at 7:00 P.M. The Board examined the budget worksheet as submitted by the Fiscal Officer. The Board asked several questions about several items which were answered by the substitute Fiscal Officer, Mr. Brewer.

Mr. Pancost made a motion to accept the tentative budget for 2013 as submitted by the Fiscal Officer, Ms. Schulda seconded the motion. Chairman Groselle called for a vote on the Budget. Mr. Groselle AYE, Ms. Schulda AYE, Mr. Pancost AYE.

Resolution # 2012-11 to approve the Hiram Township tentative 2013 Tax Budget was approved.

Chairman Groselle opened the meeting at 7:15 P.M. Chairman Groselle Recognized representatives from Keystone Oil. The Keystone representatives explained who they were and how they hope to work with the Township while they were drilling wells in the Township in the near future. A meeting was set up for public input and discussion on July 24, 2012 at 7:00 P.M. at the Hiram Christian Church. A discussion ensued with residents in attendance referring to the drilling of wells in general.

Chairman Groselle recognized Mr. Todd Peetz from Regional Planning. Mr. Peetz described how he could work on the Community Plan and the cost involved. The Trustees will examine his proposal and take action at a later date.

Old Business – Mr. Pancost sent a letter to the Crestwood School Board in support of transporting students to NEOMED next year.

Ms. Schulda asked for an update list of Zoning Board and Board of Zoning Appeals members. Ms. Schulda asked for the addresses of Frontier and Mr. Schrader to be updated by the Fiscal Officer. Ms. Schulda went over items needed for the condemning of structures in the Township. Mr. Groselle discussed a ballot for members of Region 7 of OPWC with the other Board members. A vote was taken and the ballot was marked. Mr. Groselle will send it in.

New Business – Ms. Schulda made a motion to ask the County Prosecutor to take action against Senneff for a zoning violation. Mr. Pancost seconded the motion. Voice vote: Mr. Groselle AYE, Ms. Schulda AYE, Mr. Pancost AYE.

Resolution 2012-12 to file against Mr. Senneff for a zoning violation has passed.

Roads Report – Mr. Matota observed a company doing some seismic testing in the area and reported it to the County Engineer but no action was taken. Mr. Matota reported that work on Schustrich Road is nearing completion and that chip and seal work will begin next week depending on the weather.

Ms. Schulda made a motion to pay the bills and adjourn. Mr. Pancost seconded the motion. Voice vote: Mr. Groselle AYE, Ms Schulda AYE, Mr. Pancost Aye. The following bills were paid and the meeting was closed.
