Regular Meeting Minutes September 4, 2012 7:00 PM

Present: Chairman Groselle, Steve Pancost, Kathy Schulda

Chairman Groselle opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and the reading of the August 21, 2012 minutes. Steve Pancost motioned to approve the minutes as corrected. Kathy Schulda seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Groselle AYE, Pancost AYE, Schulda AYE. The minutes were approved.

Fire report: The Chief said that all is being handled.

Old Business: Steve will be getting a bid from Carter Lumber for the repair of the Townhall Building. Jack has received a bid from J & R Painting and from JHI Painting. The bids will be redone and brought to the next meeting.

The Highway Use Bond Number 238243 will be released on August 30, 2012. The County Engineer has checked the roads and determined that they are in acceptable condition

Kathy asked about Thrasher/Rapids Road properties. Nothing from Middlefield Bank and the other property will be sent a letter asking what they are planning.

The Fine from the State Tax Office is because they have not received the year end IT 941 form. The form will be sent and most of the penalty for not filing will be waived.

Kathy has gone in front of the Hiram Village Tax Board and has not received any response yet.

It has been reported that the Zoning phone is still active. It is and Windstream will be contacted again.

Jack and Kathy are continuing to work on a recycling plan for the Township, Village and College. They were at the Kimble Recycling Center in Twinsburg this last week. He stated that all communities should have curb side service now.

It was suggestive that something be done to honor Mr. Wally Ellenberger for his 30 years of Fire service. He passed away on September 2, 2012. It was suggestive that memorials to the Hiram Fire Department would be best.

New Business: A discussion about the web site was started by Kathy. We will be looking for bids to run our web site at the end of the year. The current site is paid up till the end of this year.

Jack said that any dust problems from motorcycles or other things may be a zoning issue and to contact the Zoning Inspector.

Zoning Report: Rich reported that some zoning permits have been issued and he is continuing to work with Chris Meduri concerning the Seneff property.

Road Report: Tom Matota reported that a repair to the paver will be around \$600.00 and the needed material for Schustrich Road was only around \$3000.00 and not \$6000.00. They will be working on Alpha Road and he asked about what can be done with Asbury road concerning the beavers. Jack said he will check again with Scott from the Soil and Water Conservation Service.

Tom has also talked with Sue Hoover from the Mantua potato Festival. She was asking if Pioneer Trail could be closed for the race from 9:30 till 11:30. Tom will provide her with "Road Closed" signs for this.
