

HIRAM TIRE CLEAN UP



Mark your calendars – The Hiram tire clean-up is scheduled for **Saturday May 18th, 8:00 a.m. to Noon**. Bring tires to the Rosser Municipal Building public parking lot located at 11617 Garfield Road, Hiram.

The Portage County Solid Waste Management District is strictly enforcing the following:

- A strict limit of ten (10) tires per vehicle will be accepted at the collection event. The Ohio EPA requires a “Tire Manifest” for anyone transporting more than ten (10) tires per load. Transporting more than ten (10) tires without appropriate documentation is a felony. This requirement is per the Ohio Revised Code 3734.83 (D).
- *Passenger tires with rims will be accepted.*
- *Tractor tires with rims will be accepted.*
- Cut (sheared) tires will not be accepted.
- Tires that are muddy or filled with dirt will not be accepted.
- Semi tires cannot be accepted.
- Heavy equipment tires or treads from mini excavators will not be accepted.
- No chunks of rubber.
- No inner tubes.
- Tires will not be accepted from commercial businesses.
- Tires will not be permitted to be stacked over the edges of the collection containers.
- No after event hours “dumping” of tires permitted.
