 details related to the Zoning of such things and what some of the other Townships in the area are doing. Ms.
 Blake motioned the following: Prohibit operation of any large or commercial Solar and Wind farms within Hiram

Mr. Pancost is working with Todd Peetz at Regional Planning regarding possible grant money available via Gail Pavliga (Ohio House Representative) for Parks improvements. The Township is asking for \$250,000 in grant money to build a slightly less than a mile trail and two pavilions on the Township property that would be available to the residents of the Township.

The Trustees discussed the growing of marijuana within the Township. After some deliberation, Mr. Groselle motioned the following: Prohibit adult use cannabis operators and medical marijuana cultivators, processors and retail

dispensaries within the unincorporated area of Hiram Township, Ohio. Ms. Blake seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote on the Motion: All Ayes. **Resolution 2023-035**

Mr. Groselle received a call from a resident of Rolling Meadows regarding being allowed to sight his gun. Mr. Groselle told the resident that is perfectly acceptable within the Township.

Road:

The new salt spreader is being mounted onto the Township truck. The Air Compressor parts to repair the Road Department's compressor has been received and is in process of being repaired. Mr. Matota is ready for winter as the salt bin is fully stocked and ready for inclement weather.

The Board asked Mr. Matota to mount a dry erase board on the back wall of the Meeting Room. The Board reminded Mr. Hankinson to make sure that some money be added in the 2024 appropriations to cover the eventual install of a city water line to the Township Facility to replace the rusty well water the Facility currently has. Mr. Pancost suggested that the Board bid the project out to do the water line install.

The Board also mentioned that OPERS will be around 18% contribution rate in 2024 so to plan for that.

Zoning:

Asbury Rd – Addition, many calls also from real estate/title agencies. Questions about a possible subdivision at the farm on Rt 305 that was recently sold. The Ground Guys did 3 mowings on the property on Winchell Rd, the Township was billed for that. The cost will be passed onto the owner as a lien on the property.
